



**STATE OF NEW MEXICO
PUBLIC EMPLOYEE LABOR RELATIONS BOARD**

**Minutes of Board Meeting held Tuesday, March 6, 2018 9:30 a.m. at the PELRB offices,
2929 Coors Blvd. NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico; Duff Westbrook, presiding.**

1. **Call to Order.** Chair Westbrook called the meeting to order at 9:31 a.m. Member Jay Bledsoe was in attendance and Vice-Chair R.E. Bartosiewicz appeared telephonically. Consequently, a quorum was present.
2. **Approval of Agenda.** Member Bledsoe moved to approve the agenda. Chair Westbrook seconded the motion and the agenda was approved 3-0 after a roll call vote.
3. **Approval of January 6, 2018 meeting minutes.** . Member Bledsoe moved to approve the minutes of the February 6, 2018 meeting. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chair R.E. Bartosiewicz and upon a 3-0 roll call vote the minutes were approved without modification.
4. **Public Comments.** There were no public comments.
5. **Voluntary Dismissals.** Director Griego noted that there were two matters under this agenda item: First, *Santa Fe Police Officers Ass'n/Fraternal Order of Police v. City of Santa Fe*, PELRB No. 119-17 and, second, although titled "*Hall v. City of Belen*" it was actually "*Hall v. Belen School District*", PELRB No. 121-17. In each matter the parties settled their disputes, The PPCs were withdrawn and a voluntary dismissal entered. There was no action for the Board to take.
6. Chair Westbrook moved to table the matter of *Cullison v. Santa Fe County* to the next meeting. That motion was seconded by Member Bledsoe, and the motion passed 3-0 after a roll call vote.
7. **Certification of Election Results.** Director Griego reminded the Board that at its February meeting it approved a Consent Election Agreement for the parties in *Communication Workers of America v. Third Judicial District Attorney's Office*; PELRB Case No. 310-17. The election took place as scheduled on February 16, 2018 and Mr. Griego presented the results:
 - a. 11 ballots were cast out of a total of 11 eligible voters. Therefore, more than 40% of the eligible voters cast ballots so that the election was valid.
 - b. Nine ballots, a majority of those cast, were in favor of representation by the Communications Workers of America . Two ballots were cast for "No Representation".
 - c. Accordingly, the Petitioner has shown sufficient majority support under PELRB rules so that it should be certified as the exclusive bargaining representative for the unit petitioned for.

Chair Westbrook moved to approve the election results and direct Director Griego to issue certification of the bargaining unit representative. His motion was seconded by Member Bledsoe, and the motion passed 3-0 after a roll call vote.

8. **Next Meeting Date and Adjournment.** The Board set Tuesday, May 1, 2018 9:30 a.m. as the next Board Meeting. Chair Westbrook moved to adjourn. The Motion was seconded by Member Bledsoe and passed after a 3-0 roll call vote at 9:27 a.m.
